



Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Report
To Students
Quarterly Report October 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021

The following information is provided to comply with the Department of Education's CRRSA and ARP (a)(1) reporting requirements.

- Firelands Regional Medical Center acknowledges and has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSA and ARP (a)(1) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- The total amount of funds that the institution has been allocated from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSA and ARP (a)(1) programs is \$131,760.
- The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under CRRSA and ARP (a)(1) between October 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021 is \$88,500.
- The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) is 110.
- The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) program between October 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021 is 74.
- The method utilized to determine distribution of emergency funds are as follows:
 - All currently enrolled students are eligible to receive an Emergency Financial Aid Grant.
 - Amounts were determined a Financial Committee based on need.
 - All students were notified by e-mail. This notification included information that funds may be used toward any component of the cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus such as tuition, food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and child care expenses.
 - Awards were direct deposited into each students' provided bank account on October 29, 2021 with the exception of 2 students that did not have banking information on file. Those students received a paper check.
- As of December 31, 2021, all student portion of Emergency Financial Aid Grant funds have been disbursed to students enrolled at Firelands Regional Medical Center School of Nursing.
